(Limit of two premiums will be awarded per class).

All entries must be made to the secretary by Tuesday, July 5. Any late entries will be charged an additional \$5.00. Entries may be completed online at knoxfair.com or mailed to Knox County Fair, Box 204, Knoxville, IL 61448.

Animals will be released from the fairgrounds at the conclusion of the Open Market Lamb Show.

All Market Lamb Show entries must be made by Tuesday, July 5. Any late entries will be charged an additional \$5.00.

Lambs must be born on or after January 1, 2022 to be eligible for Market Class.

Lambs will be judged on the basis of weight and grade for top market lambs.

If entries include 5 head of each sex, classes will be divided by sex then weight.

Must be on fairgrounds by 4 p.m. Tuesday. Weigh in will be at 4:30 p.m. Tuesday.

All entries in pair or group class must be entered in their respective individual class to exhibit.

Classes will be determined by Superintendents after weigh in.

Ewe lambs and Market lambs will be released at the conclusion of the Market Show.
