1. All entries in this department are subject to general rules of the Fair. Entries close Wednesday, July 5 (rules will be strictly enforced), and must be postmarked before midnight on that date to be accepted. Stock may be on the grounds after 5:00 p.m., Tuesday but MUST be checked in with Superintendent before 9 a.m. Wednesday.
2. No Shipped in rabbits will be accepted.
3. Earmark is preferred but not required. If none, place N/A on the entry form.
4. No substitutions, except in same class and sex.
5. The Knox County Fair Association will not be responsible for loss in case of fire or theft, accident or providential destruction. Every precaution will be taken to eliminate any danger or mistake in the show room and return of stock from show.
6. No breeding will be allowed in the show room.
7. All animals will be inspected on arrival and stock received in unsound condition will not be cooped.
8. Entries can be made online at knoxfair.com or mailed to Knox County Fair, P. O. Box 204, Knoxville, IL 61448.
9. The Knox County Fair presents their Rabbit Show on Wednesday, July 12 at 1:00 p.m.
10. Rabbits can be removed 1:00 p.m. Friday.
11. There will be a best of breed class, which will include all ages, does and bucks. This class will determine which animal will advance to Grand Champion and Reserve Champion Overall.
12. No refunds will be made.
13. Exhibitors may enter up to 2 rabbits in each class. (For example: 2 Satin Does, 2 Rex Buck, 2 Lion Head Jr. Buck, etc.)
14. No exhibitor may collect more than two premiums in any one class. (Fair Rule).
15. Any exhibitor removing part or all of his or her exhibit before the official release time without written permission of the Show Superintendent and Fair Secretary will automatically forfeit any premium in this division, open or youth.
16. Rabbits must use pens provided not personally owned cages. NO EXHIBITING FROM YOUR VEHICLE.
17. There will be a Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion of all breeds and sex.

Poultry intended for exhibition may be on the Fairgrounds after 5:00 p.m. Tuesday evening and by 8 a.m. Wednesday. Poultry will be dismissed at 6:00 p.m. Saturday.

Any exhibitor removing birds from the grounds and the exhibit area prior to the release time will not be paid for the premiums won. Entries must be in the hands of the Secretary on Wednesday, July 5. Entries may be completed online at Knoxfair.com or mailed to PO Box 204, Knoxville, IL 61448. Entry fees must be paid in full and will in no case be returned, and no refund of entry fees will be made to non-winners. See further rules under RULES AND REGULATIONS.

All fowls shown in this class must be purebred birds and owned by the exhibitor. Judging will be by comparison. American Standards of Perfection to govern. **Birds will be cared for, fed and watered during the fair week. Feed provided by the fair board.** Feeder and waterer must be furnished by exhibitor. Poultry showing any symptoms of disease will be excluded from competition and from exhibit tent.
